**RE:           Permission to Use the Term "Eagle Scout"**

Dear Mr. Park:

I represent a number of individuals who received their Eagle Scout from the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) and are now residing and working in the United States. Several of my colleagues have shown interest to associate themselves with other Eagle Scouts, yet were unable to do so due to membership restriction of the National Eagle Scout Association (NESAs). Noting this restriction and in hopes of furthering our mutual goals of supporting the local Scouting programs of our new found communities, we have decided to formalize our association.

We recognize that the term "Eagle Scout" is a registered trademark of the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) and we respectfully seek the permission of the BSA to allow us the use of the term "Eagle Scout" for the purpose of organizing ourselves into an organization. An option we have considered is to name our association as "Filipino-American Convocation of Eagle Scouts".

I am currently a volunteer for the Los Angeles Area Council of the BSA. I serve as Crew Committee Chairman of Venture Crew 120 in Carson, California, District Committee Member of the Pacifica District of the Los Angeles Area Council, an annual contributor to the Friends of Scouting campaign and a James E. West Fellow. It is our firm belief that creating such an association can rally support for the programs of the BSA from the untapped Eagle Scouts of Filipino-American community and serve our mutual goals.
